5. A motion was made by Mr. Glover to accept A/P warrants #66, #68 and Payroll warrants #65, #67. His motion was seconded by Mr. Fits, with four (4) voting in favor.

§ Greg LaRochelle, Safety Management Specialist from Maine Employers Mutual Insurance Company (MEMIC) will be in the town office Wednesday, January 10th to conduct an ergonomic evaluation for the office staff workstations. He will issue a report of any changes that need to be made.

§ The town auditors will be here at the next selectmen's meeting on January 22nd to provide an overview of the FY06 audit.

§ Foreclosure notices will be sent out on January 19th for unpaid 2005 real estate taxes to property owners and mortgage holders. Courtesy notices were sent out in December advising those unpaid tax owners that foreclosure notices would be going out. If payment is not received by February 25th, automatic foreclosure will take place. We have 28 accounts, totaling about \$29,000, that fall into this category right now.

§ Mrs. Jackson gave an update on Standard & Poor's Bond rating.

8. Mr. Glover moved to approve "Megan's Way" as the street name in the Farm View Vista Subdivision, as requested by Robert Ripley. His motion was seconded by Mr. Kilgore and four (4) voted in favor.
