22. Paris roads have been posted from March 15 to May 15, unless posting is lifted sooner. The weight limit is for roads in excess of 23,000 pounds or 10 tons gross vehicle weight, with the temperature higher than 32 degrees. This posting doesn't apply to vehicles of this weight if the temperature is less than 32 degrees and there is no water showing on the roads.
