2. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Town Manager, Sharon Jackson.

- 10a. Mr. Merrill made a motion to decline exercising the Town of Paris' option to purchase real estate acquired by the TPDC for the Tech Park Project. His motion was seconded by Mr. Kilgore and all five (5) voted in favor.
11. A motion was made by Mr. Kilgore for the board to enter into executive session pursuant to 1 M.R.S.A. §405(6) (E) for labor negotiation for the police union contract renewal. His motion was seconded by Mr. Merrill and all five (5) voted in favor.
