1. Mrs. Payne called the selectmen's meeting to order at 7:00pm.
2. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Town Manager, Sharon Jackson.
3. Adjustments to the agenda: Item #9a was added to the agenda.
4. Mr. Kilgore made a motion to accept the minutes of the March 26, 2007 meeting as written. Mr. Glover seconded the motion. All five (5) voted in favor.
5. A motion was made by Mr. Kilgore to accept A/P warrants #96, #98, and Payroll warrants #95, and #97. His motion was seconded by Mr. Fitts and all five (5) voted in favor.
6. Town Managers Update:
 - 16 The Planning Board will meet on Tuesday, April 10th at 7pm.
 - 17 On Tuesday, April 10th at 7pm the Comprehensive Planning Committee will hold an informational meeting at the community hall on Academy Street.
 - 18 There will be a joint EMA meeting between Paris, West Paris, Greenwood and Woodstock on Wednesday, April 11th at 10am.
 - 19 On Wednesday, April 11th at 7pm the X-tra Mile ATV club will meet.
 - 20 The Budget Committee will meet on Thursday, April 12th at 7pm.
 - 21 All town offices will be closed on Monday, April 16th in observance of Patriots Day.
 - 22 The Budget Committee will meet again on Thursday, April 19th at 7pm.

- 23 The next Selectmen's meeting will be held on Monday, April 23rd at 7pm.
 - 24 On Tuesday, April 24th at 7pm the Planning Board will meet.
 - 25 The Budget Committee will meet on Thursday, April 26th at 7pm.
 - 26 AVCOG will hold an Economic Development Day on Friday, April 27th from 9am – 2:45pm at Martindale Country Club.
 - 27 Monthly reports from the Fire Department, Police Department and Code Enforcement Officer were given.
 - 28 Updated schedules for Subdivision Ordinance and Comprehensive Plan were given to selectmen, along with an agenda for the Comprehensive plan public forum scheduled for April 10th.
 - 29 Hathaway Road will be posted with "No Parking" signs to deal with the parking issues at the end of the school day. Chief Verrier and David Marshall monitored the problem today after getting complaints. Chief Verrier is working on a "no parking ordinance" that will be brought to the selectmen for review.
 - 30 The Paris Police Officers voted to accept a negotiated 3-year contract. The contract will be ready for selectmen approval and signatures at the April 23rd meeting.
 - 31 Mrs. Jackson met with Ralph Stone last week regarding his intentions for his personal belongings and the building since the fire in February. He asked to have until the end of April to clean up from the fire and to salvage whatever he can. His intent is to pay in full all back taxes. He understands that either he or a new owner will then be responsible for doing what needs to be done with the burned building.

7. Citizens Comments: Ron Fitts asked about what he considered a definition change in the subdivision ordinance. Mr. Glover countered that it was not a definition change, only a clarification of the original definition. Several other developers/residents asked questions regarding the subdivision ordinance.
 8. The Maine Department of Labor/Bureau of Labor Standards presented The Safety & Health Award for Public Employers (S.H.A.P.E.) to the Paris Fire Department.
 9. Mr. Glover made a motion to accept the resignation of Debbie Decato from the Budget Committee. His motion was seconded by Mr. Kilgore and all five (5) voted in favor.
 - 9a. Discussion, questions and comments were heard regarding the Subdivision Ordinance and Comprehensive Plan drafts and schedules.
